

**DORSIPES SAXICOLAE, A NEW SPECIES OF MITE (ACARI: PODAPOLIPIDAE), AN
ECTOPARASITE OF AMARA (PARACELIA) SAXICOLA ZIMM. (COLEOPTERA:
CARABIDAE) FROM IRAN**

ABSTRACT - *Dorsipes saxicolae* n. sp. (Acari: Podapolipidae) is described from *Amara (Paracelia) saxicola* Zimm. (Coleoptera: Carabidae) from northeastern Iran. *Dorsipes saxicolae* is compared with 4 other species in the *inflatus* group of *Dorsipes* Regenfuss. A key to the species is provided.
