

## DESCRIPTION OF THREE NEW SPECIES OF NOTHOPODINAE (ACARI: ERIOPHYIDAE) FROM SOUTH CHINA

**ABSTRACT** - Three new species are described and illustrated in this paper. They are: *Anothopoda ichangensis* **n. sp.** infesting *Machilus ichangensis* var. *leiophylla* (Lauraceae), *Surapoda tianlinensis* **n. sp.** infesting *Litsea* sp. (Lauraceae) and *Surapoda zanthoxylumae* **n. sp.** infesting *Zanthoxylum* sp. (Rutaceae).
